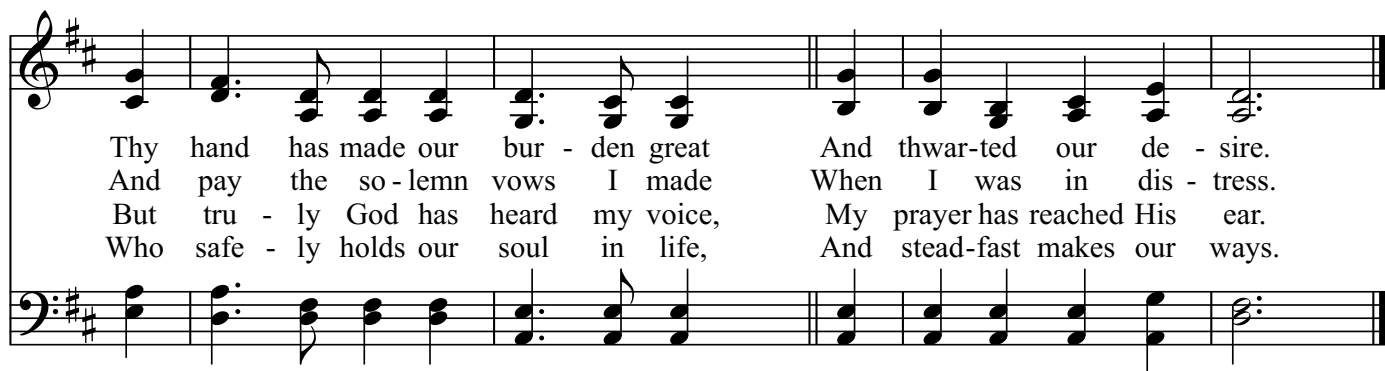
1.O all ye peo-ples, bless our God, A - loud pro-claim His praise, Who
