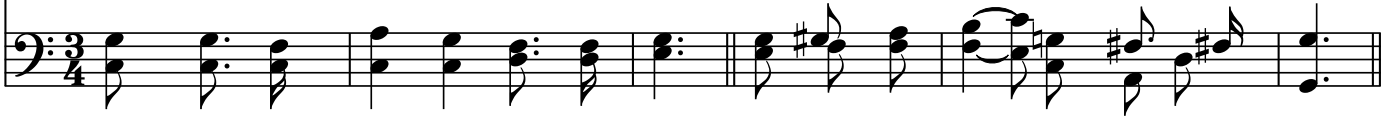


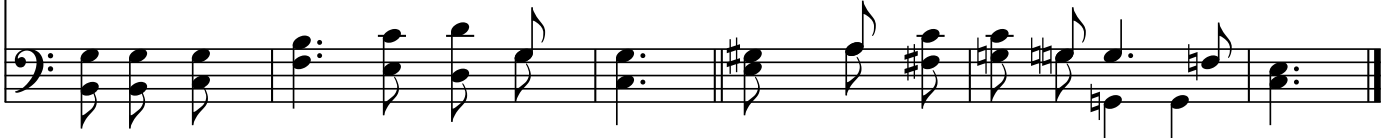
180. Manifold Mercies
