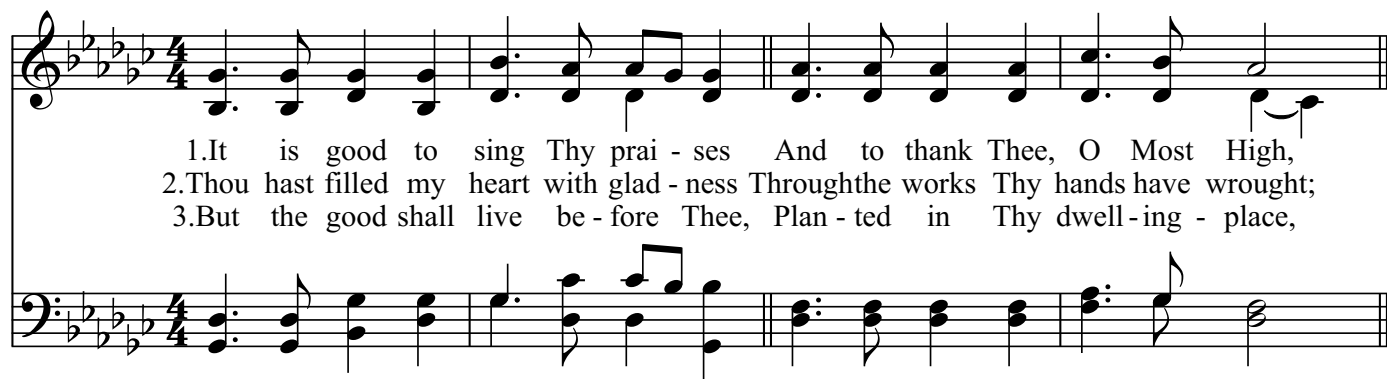

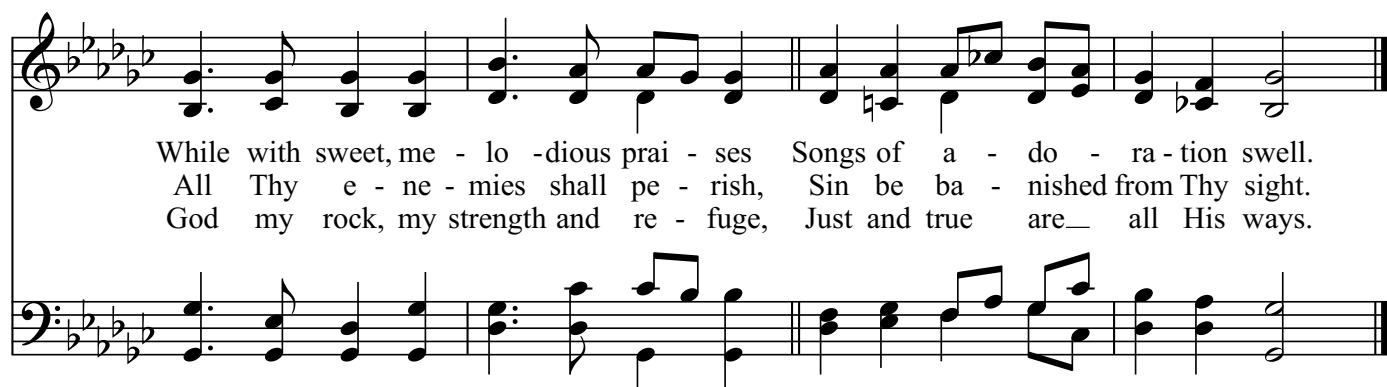
1. It is good to sing Thy prai - ses And to thank Thee, O Most High,
