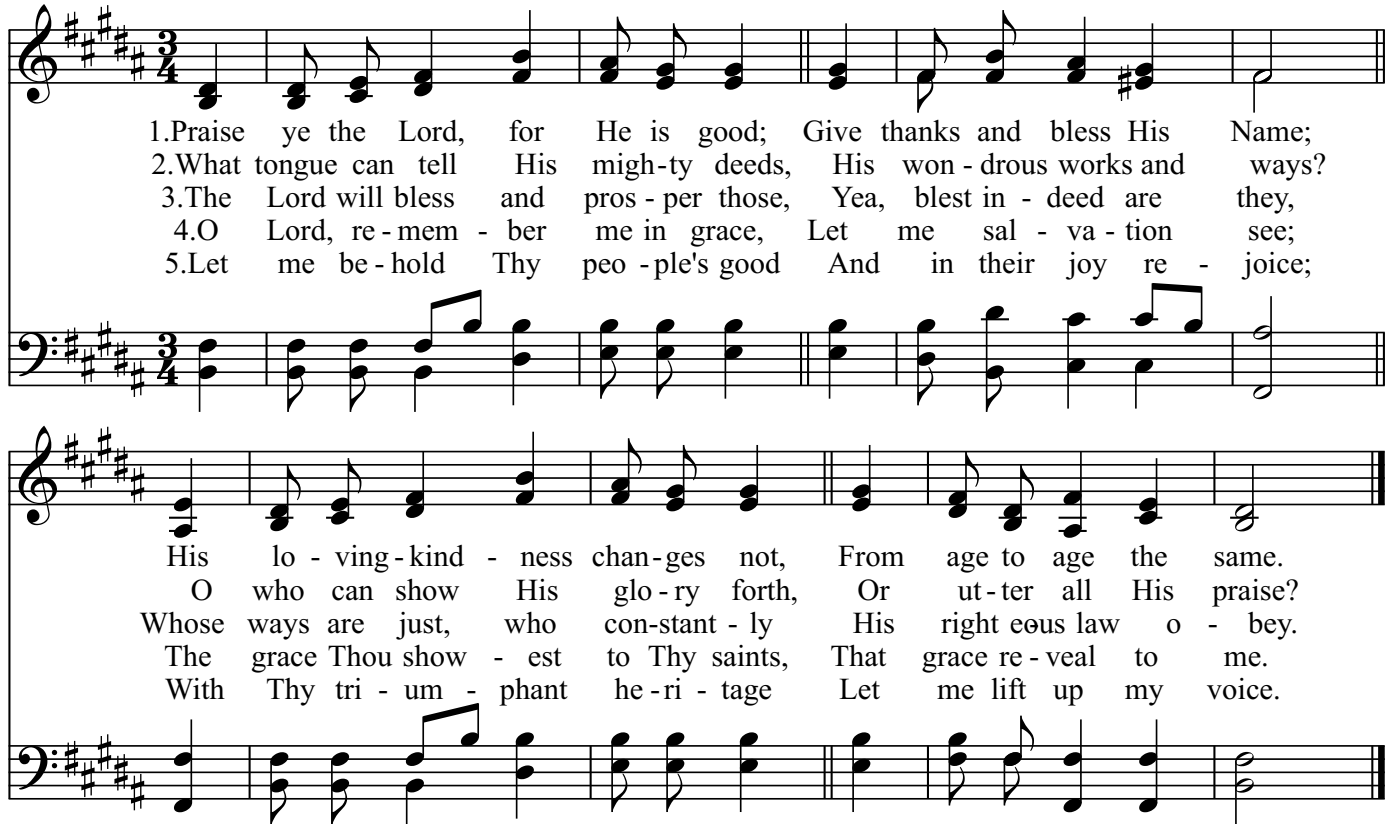


290.Praise and Confession
